# CHÂTEAU GRANDEFONT

## Bordeaux

### ORIGIN - TERROIR

The vineyards at Château Grandefont now cover 45 hectares of vines situated on the left bank of the Dordogne river, in Saint-Avit-Saint-Nazaire. The domaine was formerly planted with fruit trees before gradually being replanted with vines in the 1960's. The vineyards lie on the former river bed and benefit from particularly gravelly soils and a unique microclimate owing to their proximity to the river. The name signifies "large fountain" and the domaine was previously used as a stopover point for boatsmen transporting wine up the river towards Bordeaux.

Grassing of alternative rows

### VINIFICATION

Mechanical harvests at optimal ripeness levels  
Parcel selection  
Vinification in temperature controlled stainless steel vats

### GRAPE VARIETIES

84% Merlot  
16% Cabernet Sauvignon

### TASTING NOTES

Château Grandefont has a beautiful and intense ruby color and reveals a very aromatic nose on ripe fruit, plum and spicy notes. It is a supple, round and well-balanced wine with a long lasting finish.

### FOOD & WINE PAIRING

Château Grandefont will be ideal with a turkey cutlet in a creamy mushroom sauce, polenta or even a pork with a prune sauce and dauphinois potatoes. Or also with a slice of Brie.

Enjoy served at 18°C.
