#### **ORIGIN – TERROIR**

This beautiful château dates back to 1709 and is located on a plateau overlooking the Dordogne Valley. Its southern exposure and proximity to the Dordogne river creates an ideal microclimatic for the ripening of the grapes. The vineyard covers an area of 81 hectares in a most favourable geographical location, factors underlining the prestige of Château Picon wines.

Soil tillage and grassing Disbudding and leaf stripping

#### **VINIFICATION**

Mechanical harvests, sorting of the grapes Traditional vinification in temperature controlled stainless steel vats Oak ageing

#### **GRAPE VARIETIES**

57% Merlot

20% Cabernet Sauvignon

12% Cabernet Franc

11% Malbec

#### **TASTING NOTES**

Château Picon has a bright ruby red colour. Its nose is refined, with notes of red fruits and a hint of oak. The palate is very well-balanced with firm and mature tannins.

#### FOOD & WINE PAIRING

Château Picon will be perfect with grilled beef or goat's cheese. Enjoy served at 18°C.
